

West Point Thoroughbreds Opens Wilton Office

West Point Thoroughbreds, a New Jersey-based race horse partnership company, has opened a new office near Saratoga Springs.

The 18-year-old company which sells shares of thoroughbred horses, also has offices and employees in California, Kentucky and Pennsylvania.

The race horse syndicate, founded by former Army captain and West Point graduate Terry Finley, manages a portfolio of 80 thoroughbreds for 400 partners. That portfolio competed for \$23 million in purses last year, winning nearly \$2.9 million.

“We have a strong presence in Saratoga and with part of our team living in the area, opening an office here makes perfect sense,” said Finley, company president.

“What better place to establish a presence than near one of the most venerable racetracks in the country,” he said.

This year, the company portfolio has won approximately \$2.4 million in purses.

The new office is located just outside Saratoga Springs on Smith Bridge Road in the town of Wilton. West Point Thoroughbreds Chief Operating Officer Josh Cooper and Tom Bellhouse, executive vice president of east coast operations will be based out of the Saratoga area office.
