Footnotes

BLAME angled in early when within reach of the leaders, advanced four wide on the second turn then finished with a late burst of speed to be up in time. BATTLE PLAN controlled the pace along the inside, drew off into the stretch when ready but could not last. GENERAL QUARTERS closest to the pace off the inside, could not stay with the winner into the stretch but was coming again late. GIANT OAK reserved near the rail, moved out four wide leaving the second turn and made a late gain. DEMARCATION outrun three wide, advanced five wide into the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. ARSON SQUAD forwardly placed off the inside, drifted out in midstretch and finished evenly. A. U. MINER far back for six furlongs, found his best stride too late. DUKE OF MISCHIEF close up early along the inside, held on well to the stretch and weakened. HONEST MAN prominent off the inside, steadied in midstretch and tired. MACHO AGAIN five wide on the second turn, was no threat. NO ADVANTAGE four wide on the first turn, moved out a path on the second turn and was no factor.
