UNTAPABLE broke well, was forced inward after the runner up came in suddenly and sharply approaching the end of chute, got checked then appeared to rub shoulders with HOUSE RULES while carrying that rival over to the rail afterwards, recovered and was steered towards the middle of the strip, departed the backstretch from the three path, accelerated when let out a notch, powered by to lead the field into the stretch by a length, was almost at the three-sixteenths marker when asked for a response, gave it and drew well clear, kept to encouragement to the end. PRINCESS VIOLET broke on top and maintained the advantage, arrived at the beginning of the main track with UNTAPABLE in close attendance to her inside, veered in sharply, herding that opponent towards the inside and into making light contact with HOUSE RULES, tucked over to the rail herself afterwards, showed the way under stronger and stronger handling travelling around the turn until let out in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was overhauled by the winner nevertheless, took an erratic course down the stretch yet managed to salvage the place. AMERICA stalked the pacesetter from the two path, got shaken off after the half had been completed, spun into the stretch, gained ground steadily on a wayward PRINCESS VIOLET, missed out on the place. HOUSE RULES left the starting gate in good order, was moving willingly when forced to check getting forced over towards the rail, coming to the end of the chute from pressure originating from the runner up, dropped back considerably with the loss of momentum, sat reserved racing down the backstretch, primarily in the two path, was one wider and asked to pick it up midway on the turn, failed to respond appreciably and backed away. AQUA REGIA away last after breaking in the air, was guided over to the rail, vacated the inside route by fanning into the four path during the opening phases of the stretch run, came up empty.
