STORMIN MONARCHO stalked the pace from along the inside through the second turn, then angled outward and reached contention in mid stretch and drew clear late. ADIRONDACK KING was never far back, raced two wide on the last turn, reached contention late and was outfinished. YOGOTTHATGOINFORU pressed the early pace, contended on the backstretch then drew clear on the far turn but gave way late. VAN PERSIE was slow early, raced along the two path on the far turn then angled outward and made a late bid. TWIN ENGINE was void of early speed, raced along the four path on the second turn, then made a mild bid late. INTEGRITY vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the last turn, then faltered in the stretch. PLAINVIEW was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then faded in the drive. GROUND TRANSPORT vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the second turn, then faltered in the lane. IRSAL was close up but was through early and outrun.
