Footnotes

MADAMOISELLE BOND (GB) broke inwards bumping a rival, was collected, then angled to the rail to stalk just off the first flight under light rating racing into the bend, saved ground through the turn, switched out in upper stretch and produced a sustained response under firm handling to wrest a narrow advantage in time. PUNTSVILLE broke readily to dispute the pace outside foes in the opening stages, was urged to gain a clear advantage midway through the backstretch while angling to the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin through the bend, was urged to go clear in upper stretch, grudgingly resisted the winner's bid while shifting out brushing that foe in late stages but came up only second best. BUBUZELA, off slowly, tracked the leaders three deep between foes off the second flight early, steadily made her way nearer to the inside splitting rivals racing into upper stretch and gained a share while never menacing the top pair. KITTY'S CASTLE, forwardly placed three deep tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, continued in pursuit of that foe in that path on the turn to upper stretch and gave way. SEE THROUGH settled into stride off the inside while dropping into last on the backstretch, angled out racing into the lane and gained some position while making no real impression. AFTERMARKETSPOILER tracked the leaders four wide in the second flight racing to the turn but never mounted a serious challenge. GHOSTRUNNER, bumped at the start, was reserved off the second flight along the rail racing into the

turn but failed to produce a closing response. SPRING AGAIN threw her head at the start, was righted quickly to gain some position between foes in the second flight, was clipped by TAM, then steadied sharply leaving the half mile marker, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch but had no closing response. TAM, forwardly placed along the inside prompting the pace in the opening stages, made a sharp move switching outside the leader while clipping SPRING AGAIN leaving the half mile marker, was prompted to make a brief bid between foes racing into the turn but emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
