**HOTTAP** went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, made an outside bid in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong, fought with runner-up in the final sixteenth while rubbing saddles with that rival and narrowly prevailed. **WEST VILLAGE** was away awkwardly, went three wide on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, launched a rally while five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, closed strongly to make a bid inside the furlong marker, dueled with the winner while rubbing saddles in the final sixteenth and was denied. **SAME AS** went four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, advanced five wide into the stretch, chased under a drive into the final furlong and finished willingly for the show. **KING PTOLEMY** raced in the two path on the first turn, was reserved near the back, came under urging while two then three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy. **TICFAW** went three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along between horses while in the two path on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and also finished willingly but lacked a winning kick. **TRUE FLAT** raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong then weakened. **DEFONDO** dropped to the rail early on the first turn, settled on the inside, was held up behind horses on the far turn, waited while blocked turning into the stretch, angled out around the three-sixteenths and lacked the needed response. **ALLAMERICAN MUSIC** moved in early, was well placed on the inside, chased along the rail on the far

turn, bumped with BIG RED CHARLIE at the quarter-pole and tired. A STEP AHEAD went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the turn, was crowded between horses in upper stretch and came up empty. ACT OF HEROISM raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn, waited while blocked at the quarter-pole then failed to threaten and was vanned off after the race. BIG RED CHARLIE went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn, bumped with ALLAMERICAN MUSIC at the top of the stretch and had nothing left.
