BIG ZIP came away in good order, was hustled to the lead, set the pace under pressure, vied along the rail on the turn, kicked clear into upper stretch, was put to the whip at the three-sixteenths and drew off under strong urging. HERE COMES TOMMY settled under some restraint, drafted inside for most of the turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and proved no match while able to get the place. NOBODY MOVE was forwardly placed on the outside, came under urging leaving the backstretch, chased four wide on the turn, spun five wide into the stretch under the whip, pursued the winner into the final furlong and weakened then was caught for the place. E J'S LEGACY settled at the rear of the field, was urged along in the two path for most of the turn, dropped to the rail late on that bend, cut the corner into the stretch and improved position without threatening. RO BEAR broke a bit awkwardly and near the back of the field, settled off the pace, was coaxed along passing the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn, was asked for more in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. WINE NOT bumped with BEST VERSION at the start, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then three wide on the turn, passed the five-sixteenths under the whip and was no factor. CAUSE FOR SURPRISE pressed the pace loosely between horses, vied in the two path on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, dropped back under a right-handed whip while drifting out a bit and tired. MAN OF WIREGRASS tracked the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, came four wide into the stretch and capitulated. BEST VERSION bumped with WINE NOT at the start while last away, angled in around the five-eighths, settled near the back, saved ground on the turn and faltered.
