**Footnotes**

CORE PORTFOLIO broke in a the start pinching PROPHET'S CAT between foes and bumping THIRD SON, established the front taking to the inside into the first turn forcing WINE NOT to steady briefly at that juncture, showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until confronted by the runner up five-sixteenths from home, came under coaxing at that station, cut the corner into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive kept to task. TWO DOWN ONE TO GO forwardly placed just off the inside in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing midway on the turn advancing to issue a challenge through the latter portion nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home, got shaken off by the top one and ran on to chase the winner home and to secure the place honors. WINE NOT inside early on, briefly steadied seven and a half furlongs from home off the heels of CORE PORTFOLIO who took to the inside into the first turn, settled inside through the opening bend before taking to the two path down the backstretch while just off the pace, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, spun three wide into upper stretch and kept on through the lane to secure the show honors. PROPHET'S CAT pinched back between foes at the start due to pressure from CORE PORTFOLIO breaking inwards, settled two to three wide near the rear, came under a ride at the three-eighths, angled six wide for home, kicked on belatedly for the last major share. HERE COMES TOMMY saved ground in mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs out, swung just off the inside for home, made a mild bid to the furlong grounds then weakened in the late stages. THIRD SON bumped at the start by CORE PORTFOLIO breaking inwards, chased four then three wide under encouragement from midway on the far turn, cornered three wide into upper stretch and offered no response. RO BEAR three wide through the opening bend, settled just off the pace three wide, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and weakened in the drive. BIG AL PARKER lost his back footing at the start getting away slow, settled just off the inside near the rear, came under encouragement midway on the far turn, angled five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. BACK SCATTER three to four wide in pursuit from near the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home, spun five wide into upper stretch and tired. FULL OF MINE three wide through the first turn, chased four to five wide down the backstretch before tucking to the two path half a mile from home, came under urging

three wide three furlongs out, went four wide into upper stretch and made no impact.
