COURT SAVVY was sent to the early lead, shook clear and moved to the rail, set the pace then held sway under a brisk hand ride. AYE AYE CAPTAIN raced in midpack, angled from the rail to three-wide on the turn then rallied gamely outside rivals. FRONT NINE stalked the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch then finished all out. SKY MARSHAL stalked early then settled in midpack, chased from the rail into the stretch and finished under a determined drive. THAT'S A STRETCH settled in midpack, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn and was all out through the stretch. TITANICO stalked the pace along the rail, chased two-wide late turn but evened out in deep stretch. NO RISK NO REWARD dropped back early, saved ground while trailing the field but never reached contention.
