AWESOME GEM chased inside then a bit off the rail, went around a rival on the second turn, came out in the stretch and closed gamely under urging to get up late. MIDNIGHT LUTE four wide into and on the first turn, chased outside, bid four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, lugged in despite left handed urging in the final furlong, steadied briefly a sixteenth out and was caught late. BROTHER DEREK pulled between horses then three deep on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, bid three wide on the second turn and between foes into and through the stretch and held third. ARSON SQUAD settled outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and found his best stride late. HALO STEVEN prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn to take a short lead, continued inside into and through the stretch and weakened late. SPRING AT LAST chased between foes then outside a rival, continued inside on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. BIG MISTAKE settled outside then off the rail, went four wide into the second turn and three deep on that turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. OBJECTIVE had good early speed inside, inched away on the backstretch, dueled along the rail on the second turn, fell back leaving that turn and weakened. SENSATIONAL SCORE angled in and settled a bit off the rail, went between rivals into and on the second turn and did not rally. SOUL CITY SLEW settled inside chasing the pace, split horses into the second turn, continued inside and lacked a further response. A. P. XCELLENT saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn and gave way.
