BE SMART sprinted clear along the inside, set the pace along the rail into upper stretch, extended her lead a bit in midstretch and held sway while being kept to the task. MIA'S FIRST was unhurried early, advanced between horses while four wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and finished well in the middle of the track. JUSTWHISTLEDIXIE pressed the winner in the two path into midstretch and weakened in the final eighth. SARA LOUISE was outrun for a half after breaking slowly, steadied and altered course to the outside in upper stretch and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. STAYAWAYSTELLA raced in midpack while four wide to the turn, angled to the inside leaving the quarter pole and finished evenly. YOU CAN DREAM stalked three wide into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. ATALAYA lugged in and bumped TAPITHA at the five-eighths pole, lodged an inside move on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. CLEAR CUT raced up close between horses to the turn, drifted out a bit in upper stretch and lacked a late response. FIRST TO COME HOME raced inside early, swung six wide leaving the turn and failed to menace. TAPITHA was bumped and shut off then took up sharply at the five-eighths pole and was never close thereafter.
