EL GATO MALO was settled to the backstretch, moved up to engage for the lead leaving the five eighths, dueled between rivals on the second turn, responded to mid stretch, may have been headed in deep stretch but fought back gamely late. COVER MAGIC was outsprinted and settled to the backstretch, moved alongside the winner to duel for the lead on the backstretch, continued to duel on the second turn, may have stuck a nostril in front of the winner nearing the sixteenth pole but was outfinished in the late stages. GHETTO (GB) sprinted clear on the first turn, gave up the advantage to the half mile pole but continued to duel inside on the second turn, remained a factor to mid stretch but was tiring in the final sixteenth. AUTISM AWARENESS was fanned five wide on the first turn, settled to the half, rallied two wide on the second turn, loomed boldly between rivals leaving the furlong marker but lost his punch in the late stages. MISSISSIPPI GOLD trailed throughout.
