Footnotes

YES I'M CLEVER dropped back slightly on the far turn, rallied along the rail entering the stretch, made a run inside to challenge in midstretch and prevailed under steady urging. THATS A GOOD THING settled just off the pace, angled out on the turn, drifted out and brushed with RETRIEVER in upper stretch, battled heads apart leaving the furlong marker and yielded grudgingly. MADISON HEIGHTS dueled in the two path most of the way, fought gamely through the stretch and yielded late. BUZZIN AND DREAMIN raced inside to the turn, altered course and steadied while gaining in midstretch and finished well in the late stages. FROSTY DIAMOND broke awkwardly, raced inside early, swerved eight wide while racing greenly at the quarter pole and rallied mildly in the middle of the track. TRUE ALLY stalked three wide to the top of the stretch, was bumped in upper stretch and weakened. MIDTOWN BAILEY steadied in tight at the half mile pole, saved ground to the turn and lacked a rally. AIN'T NO STAR steadied in tight along the backstretch and was never close thereafter. RETRIEVER broke outward at the start, pressed the pace outside, was bumped by THATS A GOOD THING in upper stretch then steadied while lacking room in midstretch. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run there was no change in the order of finish.
