MOONSTER tracked the pace early, took over and led three wide into the lane then edged clear late in the stretch under a steady drive. NIGHT OPS was back early on, swung into the six path in the turn, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. PLUS QUE PARFAIT dueled early on, angled off the rail into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. TWELFTH LABOUR broke in at the start, dueled early on, shifted into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. CURLIN GREY was back early on, shifted into the four path in the turn with some gain in the stretch. GRANDGRAN chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. DICTATOR had early speed then folded up. POST CLOSE was through after three quarters. CHARLES T was bumped and bothered at the start then was through after a half. CHASING HAPPY was pulled up and vanned off.
