ALL AMERICAN HERO set the pace early, was on the inside into the lane, remained clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. LAKE NAKURU stalked the pace early, was on the inside into the lane, altered out down the lane while making a bid but hung in the late stages. MY AMERICA was bumped at the start, tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. AND SEEK came out at the start, chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. PAINTED CANYON was on the inside into the lane and improved position in the stretch. BOOBY TRAP shifted into the four path in the far turn and improved position down the lane. D TWO chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch. TACTICAL QUALITY showed little. PETER THE GREAT was bothered at the start, raced always back and was vanned off after the race. QUITE A BIT came in at the start and showed brief speed.
