CONSTANT KNIGHT off the inside throughout, pursued the front runners two to three wide on the turn, began to pick up interest during final stages of the run around the bend, swung four wide into the lane, straightened away and began to pick up real estate readily, shot by the duelers in the final sixteenth and drew clear, crossing the wire set down to a hand drive. WILD WILLIAM broke in line with CHASINDAMONEY, remained hitched up to that opponent as a prolonged duel between them commenced, saw the closest pursuers began to close the gap once more than halfway around the bend, settled into upper before switched over to stronger handling, proved no match after the winner burst upon the scene with approximately a sixteenth to go, battled onward with willingness to win the place. CHASINDAMONEY away forwardly placed, cut over to the inside holding a thin slice of a lead, went at it side by side with the runner up to the outside seemingly from the get go, was the first of that pair to have its pilot commit to a drive, this occurring a short distance from the quarter pole, got headed by the nemesis in midlane, fought well thereafter but had to settle for the show. CAUSFORCECELEBRATION quickly spotted along the inside route, took it for nearly a half, got angled five wide into the stretch, made no impact. KAVANSBERG took up the chase towards path two, between rivals until the top of the turn, got roused in the general area of the five-sixteenths marker, stepped into the lane, had no response and backed away. SIGGYLONGSTOCKINGS in the two path stepping onto the turn, was never in the hunt. SHADESOFBRILLIANCE hung out three to four wide on the turn, was always outrun.
