FACE IT powered up to the front end under her power after the break, was held in reserve showing the way towards path two for six furlongs, arrived at the three-sixteenths marker with none hitched up and was given her cue, dug in well to stay sufficiently in the clear. HARKNESS stalked the winner in the middle of rivals from path two, inched up to the one to catch during the final strides of the run around the bend, settled in upper stretch and was set down, got staved off. PEACHES AND SPICE pursued FACE IT while taking the three path on the turn, had the pilot lose the whip in the general area of the quarter pole, finished well enough in the late stages to save the show. TAKE CHARGE TINA three wide and in between rivals on the turn, missed out on third. AIKENETTA departed the backstretch from the three path, lacked the needed response. BEST PERFORMANCE away last, proceeded along in a sluggish manner on the chute, picked it a bit to rejoin the others coming up to the half mile pole, was gradually tipped into path four, came under a drive for the drive home, lugged in right around the three-sixteenths marker then immediately gave way. OUT OF TROUBLE disputed the pace from along the inside for a half and faltered.
