SECRET TOUCH angled in and dueled outside a rival, took the lead and kicked clear on the second turn and won clear under urging. TOPGALLANT four wide into the first turn, chased off the rail then outside on the second turn and alongside a foe in the stretch and edged that one for the place. RHETTBTULER between horses early, angled in and dueled inside, stalked along the rail leaving the second turn and was edged for the place. ORIGINAL INTENT angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. JERSEY'S HEAT saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. TYPHOON HARRY stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn and outside a foe into the stretch and weakened. MIDNIGHT SOOT five wide into the first turn, chased outside then alongside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
