BREAKING LUCKY went up to duel for command inside BELLE TAPIOSSERIE midway up the backstretch, began edging away while moving well off the rail past the five-sixteenths, settled into the stretch well in command under vigorous hand urging, and widened under a mild late drive. MR ATILA hopped up and inward at the break pushing THIRD DAY into HY KODIAK WARRIOR, stayed in range behind the first flight to the turn, was roused to go after BREAKING LUCKY nearing the stretch, could not get to that one but continued on clear of the others. EYE OF A JEDI lagged well back three to four wide for six furlongs, rallied between horses near the eighth-pole and was along for the show spot. THIRD DAY was pushed into HY KODIAK WARRIOR by MR ATILA at the start, hugged the rail well back around the turn, stayed inside and improved position late. HY KODIAK WARRIOR bumped with THIRD DAY at the start, trailed in the two-path to the top of the lane, and passed tired horses. RED CRESCENT bumped with BELLE TAPIOSSERIE at the start, raced widest up the backstretch within range, lost ground five wide around the turn and offered nothing further. BIBLICAL saved ground advancing in the second

flight to the stretch, but could not sustain the rally. BELLE TAPISSERIE bumped with RED CRESCENT at the start, led exiting the chute pursued from both flanks, hook up in a dispute outside BREAKING LUCKY through the middle stages, could not match strides late on the turn and gave way. IMPERATIVE was outrun throughout two to three wide. MUCHO PROSPECT prompted the pace four wide, and weakened nearing the stretch. SHAGAF sat perched outside the leaders three wide to the turn, but gave in well before reaching the lane.
