Footnotes

WOODBURY settled towards the back of the pack after the start, narrowed in coming up to the conclusion of the backstretch, departed if from path four, vied as the outmost of a trio for command, spun into the lane as the new leader under a hard drive, straightened away and shook free. PIER FORTY brushed with SCOTTY BROWN after losing his footing springing from the starting gate, steadily advanced on the front runners approximately four wide on the turn, reached the quarter pole looming boldly with momentum, tipped slightly wider at the top of the lane and took off in earnest after the one to catch, wasn't able to task at hand, but had enough to secure second. BEBE BANKER along the inside route disputing the pace against two others to the outside, got eased back at the half mile pole, stayed within striking distance, flashed some interest getting roused as three-quarters was being completed, flattened out. MAKE MOTIME came in right after being released by the starter after being pulled off WOODBURY, recovered and took up the chase well rated in the the two path, swung five wide into the lane, made no impact. SCOTTY BROWN brushed from both sides at the start, settled into path three, was one of three arguing for control for most of the opening six furlongs, going about the task from between rivals during the run around the bend, stepped into the stretch and gave way. KLICKITAT made light contact with SCOTTY BROWN in the shadow of the starting gate, was maneuvered into path two, contended with two others, albeit not always the same twosome, for three-quarters before faltering. All riders carried an additional two pounds as mandated by a weather-related safety initiative.
