B'S TEN bumped hard with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, drafted inside on the far turn, rallied near the rail while put to a drive in upper stretch, made a bid into the final furlong, kicked clear under a right-handed whip approaching the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under strong handling. CRIMSON FELINE went four then three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer late on the backstretch, steadied between horses near the three-eighths, went around the far turn in the two path, came three wide into the stretch while put to a drive and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. DIXIE BREES bumped hard with foes on both sides at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled outside in third position, raced three wide on the far turn, floated five wide while roused into the stretch, made an outside bid at the three-sixteenths, lost touch with the winner approaching the sixteenth-pole and proved no match then lost the place while able to get the show. KOOL AID GIRL moved in entering the first turn, saved ground on that bend, was unhurried at the rear, moved out of last late on the backstretch, went two then three wide on the far turn, moved out while put to a drive in upper stretch, reached a reasonable striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed response. MI COPA REBOSA disputed the pace on the inside of a rival while racing in the two path, came under light urging on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage into the final furlong and weakened. YALISHA went around the first turn in the three to four path, contested the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. SAINTS' GIRL went around the first turn in the two path, settled near the back of the field, raced inside to the two path on the far turn and failed to respond. ROSE GUITAR bumped hard with an opponent at the start and was last to commence, was taken in hand early, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, dropped back in the three path on the far turn and faltered then was vanned off after the race.
