Footnotes

A THREAD OF BLUE quick footed to take lead out of gate, secured inside position in first turn then set the pace through backstretch, remained comfortable on top, roused for more upper stretch, responded sharply and widened advantage under mild drive. ENGLISH BEE stalked the pacesetter racing along inside, roused up inside in final turn then angled out turning for home, was no match for winner but produced solid effort for runner up spot. BLUEGRASS PARKWAY raced in last flight positioned along inside, saved ground along rail through final turn, cut corner and continued steady three wide bid for share. DULL KNIFE was off step slow at start, raced three deep in last flight through middle stages, hustled up three wide in final turn then continued five wide run in stretch but lacked needed response for impact. DABO raced off the pace positioned between foes, urged for response mid-way through final turn, angled out top stretch and set down for drive but failed to kick on. JOYFUL HEART raced in range two wide through middle stages, launched three wide bid for leader near quarter pole, gained closer contention then failed to sustain bid and gaveway in stretch. KENTUCKY ALLSTAR raced in tracking mode off the leader through middle stages, launched bid for rival three furlongs from home, could not keep pace and started to fade late final turn.
