BREAK EVEN broke out at the start, stalked the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole then quickly took the lead, drew off under a moderate hand ride into the final sixteenth then was eased up late while much the best. SPICE IT UP brushed with a foe at the start, moved up then became rank behind horses, was hard held while continuing keen behind horses then was taken up in the two path early on the turn, shifted to the four path while let out near the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. LUNAR ORBIT raced just behind the leader on the inside, drafted along the rail on the turn, was taken up significantly outside the quarter-pole, lacked room while trying to squeeze through inside of CARRY THE ONE in upper stretch, found her way through inside the furlong marker then lacked the needed response while able to get the show. FURIOUSLY FAST brushed with a foe while last away, was urged along early then settled behind horses, came back under urging in the two path on the turn, swung five wide into upper stretch, drifted out some near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. SAVVY ALLY brushed with a foe at the start, settled at the rear of the field, went three wide early on the turn, dropped to the rail near the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch in the two path and failed to rally. CARRY THE ONE broke out and brushed with a rival, showed good speed and set the pace, raced in the two path on the turn, was headed just inside the quarter-pole and gave way.
