GENERAL DOWNS , forced out by TOUR DE FORCE leaving the starting gate, was rated along the rail down the backstretch and into the far turn, angled four wide at the head of the lane, secured command in upper stretch, drew clear in mid stretch, drifted in late and lasted. RICH DADDY , four wide the first turn, raced well off the rail on the far turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch and rallied outside foes. JUST CALL KENNY , bumped by SARATOGA JACK when that one was forced out leaving the starting gate, raced three wide the first turn, steadied in some traffic leaving the backstretch, moved up three wide on the far turn and flattened out late. MARENGO ROAD , four wide the first turn, saved ground the far turn, eased out in upper stretch and offered a mild gain. BONUS POINTS , three wide the first turn, swung to the five path in upper stretch and lacked the necessary late response. TOUR DE FORCE bore out on rivals leaving the starting gate, sped to the early lead, raced along the rail down the backstretch, angled to the two path entering the far turn and faded in the stretch drive. SARATOGA JACK hopped at the break, was forced out when bumped and pinched back soon after the break, was rank on the first turn, rushed up outside horses to gain the lead on the backstretch, angled to the inner rail approaching the far turn and faltered entering the stretch.
