Footnotes

CONCORD FAST settled off the pace, went three wide on the turn, was asked while four wide into the stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up in the final strides. INDIAN LOVER tracked the pace, made a bid at the three-eighths, vied two to three wide on the turn, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while just able to get the place. LAWTON tracked the pace, went three to four wide on the turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, made an outside bid in upper stretch, fought with multiple foes in the final furlong and missed while able to get the show. JOHNNY OBVIOUS showed good speed and set the pace, vied near the inside on the turn, was headed in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished. COROT was well placed just off the pace, traveled around the turn in the two path, was asked for his best in upper stretch and was out-kicked. U S MARSHAL settled near the back, moved in around the seven-sixteenths, saved ground on the turn, was roused at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. FIFTH TITLE was last away, settled at the rear on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MASKED was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four to five wide on the turn and tired. (Rail at 16 Feet)
