Footnotes

CORDMAKER, three wide the first turn, stalked the pace down the backstretch, advanced in the four path between horses leaving the far turn, gained a short lead between horses in upper stretch and drove clear late. **UNBRIDLED JUAN**, well off the rail stalking the pace down the backstretch, circled horses on the far turn, was fanned five deep entering the stretch, challenged for the lead outside horses in upper stretch and flattened out. **BONUS POINTS** hugged the rails on the turns, eased out approaching the stretch, angled to four path near the eighth pole and rallied between horses. **JOHN JONES** hugged the inner rail, disputed the pace to upper stretch and weakened in the drive. **GENERAL DOWNS**, three wide the first turn, disputed the pace three deep down the backstretch, remained three wide around the far turn and weakened the final furlong. **TWISTED TOM** hopped at the break, disputed the pace in the two path between horses and weakened in upper stretch.
