Footnotes

JUNGLE WARFARE was unhurried to the half, raced two wide on the second turn, shifted out for room and rallied to get to terms in mid stretch then dug in gamely to the line. WAR CHEST was settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, shifted out in upper stretch, rallied when set down and was second best. LYMEBYRD stumbled out of the gate, had no speed, checked at the seven sixteenths pole, was two wide but in traffic behind horses from the quarter pole to the three sixteenths, got out for room and tried to rally but stepped in and had to steady off of heels in deep stretch then finished willingly. SOUTHERN THUNDER trailed to the second turn, advanced inside to mid stretch but could not sustain the needed response. UNPOSSIBLE set the pace for six furlongs, was overtaken in upper stretch and weakened. ARMOUR PLATE pressed UNPOSSIBLE to the second turn, pushed up two wide to engage for the lead into the stretch, stayed to mid stretch then tired. BIG SHANTY tracked the pace to the second turn, was two wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive.
