Footnotes

SAINTS' GIRL settled widest of a tightly-bunched group early, moved to challenge outside rivals at the top of the stretch, wrested the lead from DREAMING DIAMOND a furlong out, and dug in to repel SWINGING BRIDGE from there. SWINGING BRIDGE saved ground on the turn, slid out to the four-path in upper stretch, had aim outside the winner but could not reach her while best of the rest. DREAMING DIAMONDS bumped with BELLA MOON at the start, vied for command inside through the first half-mile, and fought on to midstretch before yielding on the rail. BELLA MOON bumped with DREAMING DIAMONDS at the start, lost position along the rail going into the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and rallied mildly between horses late. COCKTAIL PARTY raced between horses three wide early, moved out widest for the drive and could not gain. FASHION'S TOUCH duelled for the lead outside DREAMING DIAMONDS to the turn, faltered between horses through upper stretch and was eased up late, and bled.
