VEVINA hopped slightly at the start to get off slowest, was unhurried far back as a fast pace unfolded, began moving with three-eighths remaining, rapidly reached contention around the final turn, reached the front outside rivals leaving the furlong marker and outbattled ROOM TO FINISH to the wire. ROOM TO FINISH saved ground from the start, took closer order as the field started to group back together after a mile, bid along the rail through midstretch, and finished gamely. NANTUCKET RED vied outside TWIN CHANNEL through an enervating first half-mile, took over and moved inside around the second turn, showed the way to the top of the stretch the final time, and weakened between rivals through the furlong grounds. FINESS BERE (FR) broke out bumping KITTEN'S SLEW, headed up the second flight for a mile, loomed a threat approaching the quarter-pole three wide, but could not sustain the bid. TWIN CHANNEL vied inside NANTUCKET RED through a fast early pace, deferred and went around to rebid outside that rival going to the backstretch the second time, and gave way between horses on the final turn. KITTEN'S SLEW was bumped by FINESS BERE at the start, lagged well back for the first mile, and remained uninvolved three wide off the last turn.
