**Footnotes**

TIZ MORNING got hooked up with PRESTO beginning from shortly after the start, gradually made his way to the rail on the backstretch, with the nemesis following suit by shifting to the inside and into path two himself after some lanes of separation prior, dueled head to head with the second place finisher from the top of the bend until its end, was the first to have its pilot commit to a drive, doing so coming up to the quarter pole, saw their tussle spill over into the lane, as they competed with each other on almost dead even terms, exchanging a series of leans while going at it continued onward with gameness to prove best. PRESTO broke forwardly placed, was to the outside of the winner but not directly abreast disputing the pace along the backstretch, tucked into the two path coming up to the half mile pole, vied with vigour head to head, stepped into the lane and was asked for a little more, made light contact at intervals still locked in combat with the winner, never backed off, but got denied. SPICE ROAD took an awkward initial step to the left as the field was sent off and running, yet got going rather quickly nevertheless, was set up in the three path, stayed within range of the fighting front runners, got switched over to a brisk hand ride right after the half had been completed, swung one path farther off the rail into the stretch, kicked into gear well beyond the eighth pole and nailed down the show. MEET ME IN L A struck the right side of the starting gate, cut into the two path, took up the chase on the front runners towards the back of the pack, got ridden approximately four wide into upper stretch, made some late headway. DARK STORM four wide onto the turn, lacked the needed late closing punch. FULLNESS OF TIME a forward factor four wide, gave way. RIGHTEOUSNESS strung out three to four wide on the turn, angled six wide coming up to the eighth pole, had no offering. LOOKIN AT ROSES dragged towards the two path approaching the conclusion of the backstretch, appeared green, came about a couple of paths wider onto the top of lane, then went down it greenly too. DR. ALBERT at over near the rail until the end of the bend, strolled into the lane appearing choppy-gaited, was eased then pulled up by midstretch, walked off the track without need of outside assistance.
