Footnotes

PEPPER SPROUT broke slowly, was rank entering the first turn, worked between horses on the far turn, steadied in traffic approaching the stretch, angled out in upper stretch, raced in the six path in mid stretch, closed sharply outside LEDECKA and drew clear late. LEDECKA circled horses around the turn, was four deep entering the stretch, floated to the five path when taking the lead approaching the eighth pole, finished gamely but was no match for the winner. SAFARI QUEEN , along the inner rail to the far turn, swung to the seven path in upper stretch, raced outside horses and passed tired ones. JUNE ANN (IRE) , a forward factor three deep down the backstretch, chased the pace to mid stretch then gave way. PERFECT KIND set the pace in the two path and gave way the final furlong. COMFY AND COZY hugged the inner rail and was checked in tight quarters in upper stretch. GIULIA AMMANNATI raced between horses most of the trip and gave way. CLOVER BOTTOM chased the pace outside PERFECT KIND and tired.
