**Footnotes**

OVER EMPHASIZE chased outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up in the final stride. MAGICAL GRAY had speed between horses then angled in, duled inside, inched away on the backstretch, kicked clear in the stretch and held on gamely but was edged on the line. SCATTERING MINK stalked inside then a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and held third. HAUGHTY GIRL settled outside a rival then inside, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. STORMING LADY angled in and pressed the pace outside the runner-up then stalked just off the rail to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SUNRISER stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued alongside a foe on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PLAYA CHICA pulled along the inside and steadied nearing and into the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the drive. MOLLY MCGEE broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled off the pace inside and was not a threat. CUYAHOGA FALLS also unhurried early and angled in outside a rival to the stretch and failed to menace.
