SWEET MEADOW MIST was moved over to the inside route after making slight contact with RUVIES IN TIME in the shadow of the starting gate, loped along bringing up the back of the pack, picked up speed noticeably getting maneuvered to the outside springing from the five-sixteenths marker, wound up approximately six wide a furlong down the road, maintained its momentum and rushed up to the second place finisher, latching on and sparking off a duel by the beginning of the last furlong, fought her way past a stubborn foe and to the front end in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then edged away. MADAME BARBARIAN strung out four wide, was in the same path spinning into the stretch, got turned loose clinging to a slim advantage deep into the furlong grounds, put up a fight before relinquishing a sixteenth later, had no trouble thereafter salvaging second. RUVIES IN TIME went on to press the issue between rivals after making light contact with the winner right after the start, went about her business from the two path, emerged the victor of that three-way skirmish only to have to face a fresher force soon afterwards, got called upon coming up to the quarter pole, yielded for good and backed away steadily. EXCESS CAPACITY set up in the three path after being released, disputed the pace as the widest of three for over a half and folded. TROUBLE FOR SKYLAR sent over to the rail by the midway point on the backstretch, tipped into path two entering the stretch, lacked a response. JAZZY J underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, was through after going a half, drifted six wide into the lane being protected, then was allowed to fade away. SHEZA DIVA off a half length the fastest, got sent over to the rail, was the innermost of a threesome contending for the top, gave in to the heat of that battle despite being put to a ride as the half was being rattled off, drifted five wide into the lane then tagged along with its stablemate being allowed to fade away.
