Footnotes

EL HERMANO away well, was spaced at a slight distance off the rail, proceeded to draft behind the pacesetter, was forced to remain on hold though, mired in and in amongst rivals, managed to slip into the two path prior to spinning onto the head of the stretch, increased its lead over a rallying WACKY PAL and re-tucked along the inside route by the three-sixteenths pole, was not however clear enough of the aforementioned foe, and instead appeared to make contact cutting that rival off, kicked into gear when given his cue, gained ground in a steadfast manner, wearing down QUITE OUT EAST in the shadow of the finish line. QUIET OUT EAST took up the chase three wide on both turns, swung into action by getting driven five wide into the stretch, fought his way to the front by the furlong grounds, saw the winner whittle away at the deficit, dug in well, but was nailed. JIMMY JAZZ sat in range two wide and between rivals until approaching the quarter pole, issued a challenge entering the stretch, failed to claim the top but stayed on for the show. DADDY KNOWS appeared rank seemingly from the start and would venture onward like that for over a half, was towards the inside entering the clubhouse bend but eventually left it approximately four wide, rushed up into midpack, travelled in path four on the far turn, got turned loose at the five-sixteenths pole, had a

good finish down the center of the course to grab the last major check. MY PRIMO loped along one-paced from the inside on each turn, was asked to pick it up heading for the top of the stretch, altered course into path six in midstretch, narrowed in. PIER FORTY was taken hold while directly abreast of the runner up on the first turn, went about the first turn mostly five wide, worked its way nearer the rail until in the two path by the far turn, angled five wide and was called upon for the drive home, lacked the needed response. DETERMINED ONE three wide on the first turn, went on to prompt the leader from two path afterwards, kept at the task until the top of the lane before giving way. WACKY PAL took the inside route, came under a ride cutting the corner into the lane with good momentum, bumped with the winner getting put in tight and then sawed off in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, tipped outside and flashed interest briefly before backing away. UNCLE CURLY four wide early, stayed as a forward factor, but one path closer to the rail, got set down stepping into the lane, showed some run until the furlong grounds then gave way. APEX PREDATOR set the pace from along the inside, accompanied by DETERMINED ONE to the outside, relinquished to heavy pressure in upper stretch and retreated.
