Footnotes

JACK THE CAT assumed a forward position after the start, was rated pressing the issue from path two, settled in upper stretch before being put to a drive,

out-dueled HUDSON OVERPASS then kicked away in the final sixteenth. HUDSON OVERPASS cut over to the rail with the advantage, showed the way, prompting by the winner from the outside, was put to a drive at the top of the lane being headed, stayed with the winner until the sixteenth pole, then stayed on long enough to save second. CHAMPAGNE CHILLS sat in midpack from path two stalking the front runners, between rivals for a good portion of the opening half, swung four wide into the lane, closed in, missed out on the place. LAUGHING MANNERS bumped lightly with GINGER AND JINGLE springing from the starting gate, moved inward for the next few jumps recovering, taking ELIAS GHOST along though for an abbreviated ride, raced within range approximately two wide, swung slightly wider into the stretch, flattened out. DANZANTE rank while nestled amongst rivals on the backstretch, settled down after taking up refuge in the pocket at the half mile pole, was set down spinning into the two path for entrance into the stretch, failed to make any headway in the last eighth. PRESTON COURT remained along the inside route, seen pulling for a stretch along the backstretch, stepped into the lane, narrowed in, but all accomplished without impact. BLUE PARROT responded with eagerness when put to some hand encouragement after the start, saw the rider grab hold and steady lightly several times prior to departing the backstretch, raced two to three wide on the turn, shifted out into path seven during the stretch run, improved. CAUSFORCELEBRATION travelled three wide on the turn, got asked for more as the half was being completed, was tipped out five wide once into the stretch, lacked a solid closing punch. KEEP THE LIGHT ON sighted two wide at the top of the turn, was spotted three wide at the head of the stretch, never made his presence felt. GINGER AND JINGLE bumped lightly with LAUGHING MANNERS right after the field had been released, chased the pace mildly hand urged on the turn, went into path four coming into the lane, had no offering. BANK GALA underwent a two wide trip to the top of the lane and gave way. ELLAS GHOST pushed in a bit by GINGER AND JINGLE in the shadow of the starting gate, raced mostly three wide on the turn, folded.
