Footnotes

BURFORD broke alertly and dueled for the early lead inside CHESS MASTER, shook clear around the turn, and maintained the advantage under a drive. BENEVOLENT PRINCE advanced mildly inside around the turn, finished evenly and could not threaten the winner. AVAILABLE saved ground improving position into upper stretch, and finished evenly inside. CHESS MASTER pressed outside BURFORD early, tried to get out through the turn near the three-path, and weakened. STARRY MESSENGER was two wide early, came into the stretch in the four-path and made no impact. BUNSTER chased three wide and tired after three-eighths of a mile. DRILL'S LI'L MAN faded four wide after three furlongs. SCRAPPLE lost contact with the field early and galloped along far behind.
