BANDIDO DE AMORES stalked the pace from the three path through the far turn, bid into the lane, inched up to the eighth pole then continued to slowly gain and just got up in the last yards. BARTLETT HALL set the pace from the inside from the outset, was put under pressure into the far turn, shook off one challenger in late turn, was joined by the winner into the lane, dueled with that one through the final eighth and could not hold him safe late while clearly second best. AIR WONDERFUL tracked the pace while along the inside into the far turn, came off the rail approaching the quarter pole, was in the three or four path into the lane and moved up for the show spot while never a threat. COMES N THREES was steadied when in tight early, moved to the rail, continued along the inside into the lane and was never a menace while finishing evenly. DAKOTA SHY stalked then pressed the pace while two wide through mid-turn then began to give ground to the winner and faded in the lane. CORBIN never a factor while in the two path through the turns. MICHAELS TARNATION pulled through the first turn and into the backstretch while in the two path, moved wider off the inside into the far turn and was not persevered with through the lane and was walked off.
