**ALWAYS MINING** got the class test in the Preakness and wasn't quite up for it, but he did a bit more running than the line might suggest as he was close to a solid pace all the way before taking an outside run to contention around the turn; cuts back and returns to a softer spot from a nice outside draw and his speed should play in this race. **STILL DREAMING** has much to prove going forward but he has shown some signs along the way and do think this one-turn route distance might be perfect for him; was trying gamely through the stretch while having to angle off the inside all the way, and kept gaining ground last time over a distance that might be a bit sharp for him. **DREAM MAKER** has some talent but he has been his own worst enemy out there for the most part, and he was once again compromised by a slow start in the Pat Day Mile, before making a strong wide run around the turn and racing on well for 3rd; needs to behave himself and then catch some breaks but he is good enough to go with these horses. Could tell **OUTSHINE**'s trip in the Wood was not going to work right away and he never factored there, but he is better than that and he has some speed to put into play in this spot; threat to rebound.
