REPLETE pressed the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, took over command down the lane and drew away late under a steady drive. SLICK SILVER was back early on, shifted into the three path in the turn, made a bid down the lane but flattened out late in the drive. SUPER TERRIFIC was back early on, fanned into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. COPPER FIDDLE tracked the pace early, took over the lead into the lane while off the rail but faltered late in the stretch drive. KANSAS CITY ZIP was in tight and checked early along the backstretch, fanned into the five path in the turn and improved position down the lane. YOUNG LOCHINVAR trailed the field early on, shifted into the three path in the turn, came out and bothered WRITTEN PERMISSION down the lane and improved position late. LEA RIDGE steadied early on and was no threat. MAJORS VINDICATION was through after a half. CUZI'MHAPPY had early speed then folded up. WRITTEN PERMISSION was bothered by YOUNG LOCHINVAR down the lane. LONS SHACKLEFORD had early speed then retreated. K C AGAINST WORLD had brief speed then stopped. ALL TIMES WERE HAND-TIMED DUE TO A TIMER MALFUNCTION.
