TWELFTH LABOUR stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn while making a bid, drove past the leader down the lane and cleared the field in the late stages. GALINDO was unhurried early on, angled off the rail into the lane, rallied along the inside down the lane and was up for place in the final stages. CARTE BLANCHE came in at the start and raced back early on, swung into the six path in the turn, rallied down the lane and missed place in the final stages. PROSCHEMA set the pace early along the inside, stayed on the rail into the lane and faltered late in the stretch run. GET THE PRIZE vied for the lead early three wide, led the field into the lane from the three path and faltered late in the drive. FLATOUT WINNER was in tight at the start, chased

the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn while making a bid but weakened late in the drive. COMEDIAN shifted into the four path in the turn and improved position. AQUADINI was done early. COMBINATION was through after a half. TRAVELING came out at the start, had early speed then folded up. LULLABY BLING was through early.
