Footnotes

DECORATED INVADER got set up in midpack after the field had been released, was travelling in the two path in between rivals proceeding along the backstretch, ranged up during the run around the second bend, got cued up spinning into the lane, took charge during the ensuing furlong, was comfortably in front when geared down for the final sixteenth, ventured onward losing little if any of his advantage. SUMMER TO REMEMBER away without apparent mishap, kept watch on the pacesetter loosely pocketed during the initial stages, found room to knife his wy into the two path about midpoint on the far turn, negating any chance of being shuffled by the former pacesetter who was by this juncture in the first stages of calling it a day worked his way into path three from upper to midstretch, failed to keep pace with the winner in the final furlong, but held on well enough long enough to salvage second. FAME TO FAMOUS angled sharply over to the rail after brushing into the left side of the starting gate, vacated the premises for path two approaching the half mile pole, picked up interest tipping wider a little bit down road, winding up towards path five as the third fraction was being finalized, was about as wide entering the stretch, rallied down the center of the course, missed out on the place. GLYNN COUNTY unhurried racing in the two path until the end of the backstretch, quickened leaving the half mile pole, wrested away the three path from MY SACRED PLACE in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, commenced the stretch one path farther off the rail, flattened out in the last eighth. NO BAD DAYS displaying good foot springing from the gate, vied for the top three then two wide on the clubhouse bend, was rated along the backstretch putting pressure on YUKON ERIC on the backstretch, took over when ready at the midway point of the far turn, cleared the field when put to a brisk hand ride afterwards and slid over to the inside route, cut the corner into the lane, proved no match when confronted by the winner, relinquished and backed away. MY SACRED PLACE in close proximity to a few others heading for the first turn, stumbled after appearing to take a bad step, went onward for several strides before getting going properly again, underwent a three wide trip for the first six furlongs, lost its path to GLYNN COUNTY, was in the fourth one stepping onto the head of the stretch, gave way. CITY GUY underwent a ground-saving journey and was never involved. YUKON ERIC two wide entering the clubhouse turn, cut over to the rail soon afterwards, showed the way, attended by the NO BAD DAYS to the outside, yielded readily right around the three-eighths pole, turned into the lane, went on a steady retreat, placed to a light drive.
