DANNY CALIFORNIA secured the pocket after remaining along the inside route after the start, kept an eye on PIPES within striking distance, was switched to a stronger hand ride for the run around turn two, got set down a short distance from the quarter pole, narrowed in on the leader, was sent off the inside route deep into the furlong grounds, seeking to be outside the leader, was just about to assume to control when herded then bumped into by a wayward PIPES, shook all that off and took charge anyway, kicked clear in the final sixteenth. PIPES broke on top and retained the advantage, took up residence in the two path showing the way to the end of the backstretch, rated and with JEROME AVENUE in accompaniment to her left, was set down spinning the lane, saw the top one close the gap, came out after some left side stick work in the general area of the eighth pole, all this leading DANNY CALIFORNIA to shy to the outside, ventured enough over towards the middle of strip to initiate some contact between them, had the lead snatched away, saw the new leader edge away, held on well enough long enough to salvage second. JEROME AVENUE three wide stalking the pacesetter, was one path closer to the rail on the subsequent bend continuing along at that task, got roused at the five-sixteenths pole, tipped back into path three at the top of the lane, stayed on for the show. QUALITY CHOICE underwent a two wide journey to the quarter pole, swung out four wide for the drive home, made no headway in the last eighth. SPECTATOR SPORT unhurried in path two while partnered up with HUSSAR for over six furlongs, was ridden three wide into upper stretch, was gradually maneuvered into path six proceeding to the wire afterwards, made no impact. CHILLINWITHFRIENDS parked out five wide on the first turn, was in path two by the far turn, got spotted three wide at the head of the stretch, had no offering. HUSSAR had a ground-saving journey, failed to menace.

SARATOGA COLONEL sighted four wide and pulling on turn one, travelled in path three on the second one, folded after going three-quarters.
