CRATER RIM cut over to the rail after the field had been sent off and running, slipped into the path two at the half mile pole, closed the gap, found herself boxed in at the five-sixteenths pole, quickened when let out a notch right afterwards, angled three wide into the stretch after having secured an escape route, maintained the momentum, emerging at the eighth pole as the new leader, built up the advantage to around two and a half lengths over the course of the next sixteenth, felt the presence of the winner in deep stretch but had enough to hold sway. ALREADYCELEBRATING flipped off the pilot, acting up behind the rider, went into the gate sans rider, proceeded to come away without apparent mishap, sat reserved in midpack stalking the pace from path two, cleared MOLLY'S NIGHTHAWK and cut over to the rail at the top of the second bend, got switched over to a light hand ride, cut the corner into the stretch and was soon called upon for much more, narrowed in on the ones to catch, was gradually tipped into path three between the eighth pole and sixteenth marker, flashed good late energy afterwards but fell short. FROSTY LINZ grabbed command shortly after the start, was pulling a bit on the bit showing the way during the initial stages, attended by FUSI to the outside, and with another, that being GUNBOAT DIPLOMACY in close enough proximity one path father off the rail, continued along on the same scenario for three-quarters, got turned loose spinning into the lane, was overhauled at the furlong grounds, weakened into the show slot. FUSI prompted FROSTY LINZ from the outside, put in her best challenge from upper to midstretch, couldn't gain the top then backed away. MOLLY'S NIGHTHAWK guided over to the inside before departing the clubhouse bend, fell back on the backstretch as the tempo picked up a few ticks, vacated the premises for path two as three-quarters was being reeled off, fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, becoming the widest of all, made no impact. GUNBOAT DIPLOMACY got eased back after breaking in line with FROSTY LINZ and FUSI, sat forwardly placed three wide for over six furlongs, commenced the stretch slightly wider, gave way. LOW IS LAINE strung out three wide on both turns, failed to reach a contending position. SIMMERING MISS two wide in pursuit of the front runners, got eased heading home, was soon pulled up then walked off the course shadowed by the outrider.
