Footnotes

DON JUAN KITTEN bumped at the start by VOODOO ZIP who broke inwards and in turn bumped LORD OF THE NILE into SUL MOON, established the front shortly after the start and showed the way under rating along the inside uncontested, remained on hold until set down spinning along the inside into upper stretch, dug in and held sway to the finish. SUL MOON bumped at the start by LORD OF THE NILE, raced forwardly placed under rating in the two path, tucked inside into the pocket half a mile from home, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, ran on behind the leader through to the sixteenth marker before tipping out late to secure the place honors. VOODOO ZIP broke in at the start forcing WAR STOPPER to steady off his heels when squeezed out and bumping DON JUAN KITTEN into LORD OF THE NILE and in turn SUL MOON, chased three then two wide in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside for home and kept on to secure the show honors in a blanket finish behind the winner. COUNTRY GRAMMER just off the pace four then three wide in range of the front, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the last major share. SCANNO three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive offering a mild bid but was outfinished. U S ARMY CORPS saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing just off the inside at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and made no headway. WAR STOPPER got checked at the start when shut off and pinched by VOODOO ZIP breaking inwards, chased three to four wide from near the rear, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into

upper stretch and offered no response. LORD OF THE NILE got bumped at the start and was pinched back due to pressure from VOODOO ZIP breaking inwards, chased three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide for home and offered no rally. TAPALLOOF two to three wide in pursuit from the tail of the field, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch and was unable to make an impact. UNCLE NED three to four wide in pursuit, got coaxing along at the three-eighths, continued three to four wide into upper stretch and made no impact.
