Footnotes

DOUBLE HAPPINESS unhurried in the two path for the opening three-quarters, was let out leaving the five-sixteenths marker, got maneuvered all the way towards path six after entering the stretch, mustered up a strong kick to take over in the final seventy yards, kicked clear. ROZIERE underwent a two wide pursuit for over six furlongs, was given her cue for the drive home, was worked into path from upper to midlane, rallied with willingness to garner the place. EIGHTY SEVEN NORTH stalked the pace from path two in midpack, got sent out into path five during the stretch run, finished well enough to secure the show. GO ZAPPEM sat forwardly placed three wide, moved in tandem with HERWAZE departing the backstretch as each went on to scoot by the leader during the early stages of the run around the far turn, slid over into path two once safely by the former pacesetter, vied abreast of HERWAZE, being the more confidently-ridden of that twosome, challenged in earnest at the three-sixteenths pole, wrested away the advantage as herself reeled in with approximately a sixteenth to go, stayed on for the last major check. COLD HEARTED CAT saved ground to the quarter pole, made no impact after tipping

into path two at the head of the stretch. HERWAZE stalked the loose leader from the two path during the opening phases, moved when ready stepping onto turn two, clear to the inside with the lead right around the three-eighths pole, was asked for more fending off GO ZAPPEM, was put to the test by the aforementioned rival at the three-sixteenths pole, relinquished then weakened in the final furlong. ALREADYCELEBRATING pocketed, closed the gap on the backstretch, checked behind ALEXACRAT at the three-eighths pole as that one began its steady retreat, got put to a brisk hand ride, angled five wide into upper stretch, put together a mild rally afterwards. DIAMOND DARLIN corrected after breaking to the outside with its initial step, was sluggish heading for the first turn, saved ground around it, swung three wide onto the backstretch, was in the same path leaving it, shifted out five wide for the drive home, had no response. FIKA three wide on the opening bend, was closer to the rail on the subsequent one, fanned out into path four once into the stretch, had no offering. ALEXACRAT appearing keen, spurted away from the others along the inside route, saw a pair of opponents go rolling by at shortly after entering the far turn, backed away steadily thereafter.
