Lightly raced 6 **CARRESSA** improved since stretching to two turns. She followed her maiden win with a better-than-looked runner-up finish last out in her first try at this entry-level allowance level. She was shuffled back and lost position at the break, re-rallied and loomed a threat wide on the far turn and into the lane, then lost her punch. It was a decent runner-up finish anyway. Tepid choice. 3

PERSEPOLIS stretches out for the first time since her debut in spring 2018. She raced evenly both recent sprints (maiden win, allowance runner-up), as if two turns will be to her liking. She certainly is bred to run long. 4 CYRIELLE looms an upset candidate moving up in class from a \$35k claiming N3L win. That win was better than the modest figure. She pressed a fast pace (surface exceptionally slow), and held sway. She might be the speed of the field, with a shot to get brave on the lead. KYNANCE might be ranked too low by this handicapper. She drops from N2X to run for the optional \$40k claim tag; her two starts on dirt produced a pair of runner-up finishes.
