

CLOSER LOOK: The \$2 million 2yo purchase was bet down to 6-5 odds in his debut and just ran like a horse who needed the race; was a little sluggish in the early going and steadily advanced on the turn, ultimately hitting his best stride too late; son of Tapit is out of G1 winner Artemis Agrotera and has a pedigree to suggest that the stretch-out to a mile should be perfect for him; if he takes any kind of step forward he's going to beat this field; however, you're probably going to be forced to take another very short price.
