Footnotes

BLACKBERRY WINE bumped with a rival at the start, went to the front, rounded the first turn in the two path, was well rated while setting the pace off the inside, raced in the two path on the far turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths, lost the lead in upper stretch, fought back gamely in the final furlong, regained the lead inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under vigorous urging. DIGITAL was well placed just off the pace on the inside, drafted along the rail early on the far turn, was given his cue at the five-sixteenths, gained in the two path entering the stretch, took the lead at the three-sixteenths, led into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while clear for the place. CHESTERTOWN went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was coaxed along midway down the backstretch, came under stronger encouragement while two then three wide on the far turn, swerved five wide into the stretch then drifted in near the three-sixteenths and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. RACE DRIVER broke out then was corrected by the rider, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked while three wide on the far turn, chased four wide into the stretch and tired. HEALING went three wide on the first turn, settled at the rear of the field, was urged along while inside on the far turn and failed to threaten. STRIKE APPEAL went four wide on the first turn, settled last but one, was urged along in the two path early on the far turn then moved to four wide and failed to respond.
