Footnotes

PALM SPRINGS vied widest of a foursome up the backstretch, took over outside KING KHOZAN and cleared inside soon after completing after six furlongs, was under an all-out drive through the lane and just held on. MISTER CANDY RIDE broke slowly and had ALFATEI cross over in front of him, lagged far back early, advanced to contention with a big move two then three wide around the turn, rallied through most of the stretch on the wrong lead, then switched over several strides before the wire and just missed. AWAKENED broke slowly along with the eventual runner-up, began to find stride around the turn in the two-path, closed with good energy well clear of the others and galloped out well. BEAR ALLEY bumped lightly with KING KHOZAN at the start, stayed in range early, lost ground to the leaders three wide on the turn, then ran on with good courage to earn a minor share. SIR KAHN argued the early pace three wide between horses, and weakened around the turn. KING KHOZAN bumped lightly with BEAR ALLEY at the start, vied inside three rivals up the backstretch, fought on inside PALM SPRINGS around the turn, but gave way after six furlongs. ROGUE ELEMENT was up with the leaders before backing off leaving the chute, and was finished soon after going a half-mile. MAURO'S TEAM races widest up the backstretch, and dropped well back in the four-path around the turn. ALFATEI broke inward, vied up front between horses in the two-path for a half-mile, and was finished around the turn.
