6 **BRILL** is not likely to get the same easy trip as last time when she wired the field setting slow fractions, but perhaps she will not require a perfect trip to win this Grade 3. It is true she benefitted from slow fractions, but she finished very well (23.37-second final quarter). It was the ideal confidence-builder, and if she delivers a similar rally from off the pace, she can make it two straight. **BRILL** always was well regarded, the \$1 million Medaglia d'Oro filly is living up to early promise as an older turf specialist. This field is deep however, and surface-switcher 1 **CARRESSA** is interesting despite this being her first on grass. She trounced allowance fillies last out, winning by more than eight lengths over a next-out allowance winner. **CARRESSA** has worked super since, and the switch to grass does not figure to be an issue. Progeny of Uncle Mo run on anything. Sharp filly gets a class test, and figures to be among the early leaders. Florida shipper 2 **TAKE THESE CHAINS** returned to form last out with a promising runner-up finish behind graded winner/six-time winner Mitchell Road. 'CHAINS ran well on the Santa Anita turf last winter finishing fourth behind Vasilika. 'CHAINS has tactical speed for a pressing trip. **SUPER PATRIOT** will be flying late in a race likely to unfold at a solid tempo. She is a must use.
